The wide open moorland of the Aberedw Hill is spectacular at any time of year. Leaving the farm behind, you can wander anywhere you like up here, keeping an eye out for fantastic wildlife. We are lucky to be home to many beautiful creatures, including hares, Red Kites and you may even spot some wild ponies. Take care that dogs don't seek out ground nesting birds on the Aberedw Hill such as Lapwings, Larks or Grouse from April to early July.
